We are glad you have selected Georgia Gwinnett College! As part of this Financial Aid packet, we have included a GGC Foundation Grant application. Also, for HOPE-eligible students, you must complete a HOPE application at www.gacollege411.org; click on "Applications & Transcripts" and follow appropriate links to GSFAPPS.

As a reminder, please make note of the following important financial-aid related issues:

Stafford Loan Repayment – If you have borrowed Stafford Loan funds at a previous college and are still within your in-school deferment period, you will likely not be eligible for an in-school deferment for attendance at Georgia Gwinnett College during the 2007-2008 academic year. I strongly encourage you to contact your lender to discuss all your options concerning repayment of your loans because there may be very possible options available to you; these options vary by lender. If the lender has questions concerning Georgia Gwinnett College, please direct them to me at the contact information below.

Federal Income Tax Credits – Georgia Gwinnett College does not qualify as an eligible institution with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) for the Lifetime Learning Credit and the Hope Tax Credit when you file your 2007 federal income taxes in January to April 2008.

These two issues (Stafford Loan In-School Deferments and Federal Income Tax Credits) are not long-term problems for Georgia Gwinnett College, but they are issues that take time to resolve when a college/university starts from the beginning (resolution time usually is 12 to 24 months).
